Free CPR Training

Register today for CPR Saturday from the American Red Cross and learn lifesaving skills that will better prepare you and your family for emergencies.

The Red Cross is offering FREE Cardio Pulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) classes across the Bay Area. The full value of a CPR class is \$60. The Red Cross is able to offer these classes for free during CPR Saturday due to the generous donations of several sponsors.

CPR Saturday is on March 13th. The Marin County classes will be held at the Marin City Recreation Center, 630 Drake Avenue in Marin City. Sessions will be held at 9 a.m., 11 a.m. and 1 p.m. Pre-registration is required. To register, call the Red Cross at 1-888-4-HELP-BAY or go online at www.RedCrossCPRSaturday.org.

Participants will learn:

- Adult and Child* CPR
- Care for choking victims
- 911 emergency services
- Information on how to stay safe during emergencies.

* Child CPR is only offered during the last scheduled class at 1 p.m.

Get Ready 5th Grade!

Ross Valley Fire Department's newest addition in disaster preparedness is the Get Ready 5th Grade Program. Get Ready 5th Grade is sponsored through Get Ready Marin and is designed to be presented in conjunction with the Earth science program in the local schools.

The presentation is approximately one hour long and is designed to inspire students to take the information home and be a "disaster investigator." Instruction includes providing the students with basic information on everything from fire and earthquake preparedness, to how to operate a fire extinguisher.

To date, the Get Ready 5th Grade Program has been presented to classes at Brookside Upper, Manor, Wade Thomas and St. Rita Schools. Presentations to St. Anselm, San Domenico, and Cascade Canyon Schools are expected to be completed by the end of February.

Captain Craig Carroll provided the instruction with the assistance of Wade Thomas School parent Tina Hunerberg.
