Housing Element Update

On Tuesday, July 13, 2010, the Town Council held a public hearing to consider the Town's Preliminary Draft Housing Element.

The Council directed staff to continue the item and return to a future Council meeting with the zoning for homeless shelters expanded to include the C-L, C-3 and PF (Public Facility) zones. This would include public facilities zoned PF, such as Town Hall and Isabel Cook and all commercial areas zoned C-3, which include portions of Sir Francis Drake Blvd. and San Anselmo Avenue.

They also directed staff to return with more information about the in-lieu fees for affordable housing included in the element.

The item will be heard by the Town Council on Tuesday, August 10, 2010, beginning at 7 p.m.

Robson Park and Dogs

At the Tuesday, July 13, Council meeting, there was an item on the agenda regarding allowing dogs off-leash on the lower Robson Park lawn during certain times. Because of the length of the Housing Element item, this item was continued to a future meeting. **This item will be heard by the Town Council on Tuesday, August 24, 2010, beginning at 7 p.m.**
