

The Town of San Anselmo has several low-lying areas that are prone to flooding during severe storms. Due to this, the Town has installed an early warning flood horn in the tower at Town Hall that can be heard audibly throughout the flood zones. As part of the Town's disaster plan, the horn will be sounded whenever floodwaters rise to dangerous levels. The horn will sound as follows, five blasts, a pause, five blasts, a pause, five blasts. Residents should tune to 1610 AM radio for instructions at the sound of the horn and prepare themselves for potential evacuation.

On the last Friday of every month at noon (providing it does not fall on a holiday), the Town's early warning flood horn will sound to test the system. The horn will sound in the following test sequence: blast, pause, blast, pause, blast. Please be assured that the test sequence is necessary to ensure that our early warning system is maintained in proper working order.
