Minors, Majors & Seniors Teams

Minor, Major and Senior teams are selected using a "draft" based on the results of the skills assessment. We try to balance the teams so each team will be successful and the teams are built evenly. Due to the draft process, we cannot accommodate "same team" requests for friends or neighbors. Siblings will always be placed together unless requested otherwise. In addition, once the teams are drafted, players cannot switch teams. **NO EXCEPTIONS.**

Equipment and Uniforms

All players must have their own softball glove and cleats. If you need more information on how and where to purchase gloves/cleats, call Chris at 258-4643. The league provides each team with bats, balls, helmets and other required equipment. New this year, each player will be provided a visor and a team shirt that they will be able to keep at the end of the season.
