

## **San Anselmo Parks and Recreation Commission Meeting Minutes – 09/15/09**

- 1. Meeting called to order – 7:00pm.**

- 5. Open Time for Public Expression:**
  - No public expression
- 6. Subcommittee Report – REC REACH**
  - Rec Reach effort launched on Sept. 1<sup>st</sup>. Commissioners and staff were present at most Back-to-School night events promoting the project. As of 9/15/09, 63 people have taken the survey. A link to the survey has been placed on the Town’s website, and is at the top of the main page. There should be an article about the Rec Reach project in the Ross Valley Reporter later this month as well.
  - The survey will be available until October 31<sup>st</sup>. The “raw-data” results will be sent to commissioners by November 6<sup>th</sup> for review.. The Commission will discuss the findings and make recommendations at their November 17<sup>th</sup> meeting.
  - Dave will prepare a final report which will include analysis of the findings, along with recommendations based on these findings and present it to the Commission at their January meeting. A finalized and Commission-approved final report will go in front of the Town Council at the January 26, 2010 meeting.
- 7. Staff Update**
  - a) Memorial Park Tennis Courts.
    - Public Works Director looked at courts and is going to get a 2<sup>nd</sup> opinion by mid-October. If it is found that the problem will cause long-term damage and/or the lifespan of the court will be decreased, we will proceed with fixing the courts.
  - b) Red Hill Park
    - JPA to reconvene later this month or next.
    - Use of Dog Park was discussed – it is agreed that everyone at the dog park seems happy.
  - c) Fall Sports Report
    - Youth Soccer
      - Enrollment is static.
      - New this year is a mandatory assessment and draft.
      - House leagues are moving to RHP as much as possible.
      - U12 & U14 has a Marin inter-league.

- Discussed need to assess the Youth Soccer Program and find out why people go to select soccer and Ross Recreation. Discussed the possibility of having a partnership with a parent run organization similar to the way Ross Recreation does it.
- Discussed the idea of having High School Soccer Players as referees.

#### Rookie Soccer

- Enrollment grew a little for boys.

#### Smaller Programs

- Golf showing a slow, steady rise in enrollment.
- Cross country is a new program and will take place at both Brookside and Wade Thomas this year.

#### Tumbling

- This program continues to do well. Numbers are down from this time last year.
- Discussed need to spruce of the tumbling facilities.

#### d) Online Registration

- Staff getting trained this Fall.
- Will launch with the summer program (March catalog).

#### e) Country Fair

- Still getting some parade and booth applications.
- Fire Dept will not be 100% ready for the Open House.
- Park and Rec Commission will staff a Beer Booth.
