WHO WE ARE

Our committee consists of seven members, plus two Town Council members who serve as liaisons to the Council, along with Town staff including the Town Manager, Community Services Director and Planning Director.

WHAT WE DO

In accordance with the Town's General Plan, and bearing in mind the obligation to maintain the integrity and heritage of the town, the EDC develops and implements an annual Economic Development Action Plan consisting of goals, objectives and action steps that is aimed at helping the business community stay successful and thrive.

Through the establishment of this plan, the Committee works to address challenges and opportunities facing our local business community through strategies and tactics that are achievable. For instance, a recent survey of both business owners and local consumers named lack of parking as the top challenge facing the success of the local businesses. The Committee will make this a top priority in the Action Plan.

WHAT'S NEXT?

The Committee has been working with local economist Dr. Robert Eyler to develop the Economic Development Action Plan, and hopes to introduce the 2016 plan this fall.

The EDC meets on the first Tuesday of each month from 8:45am to 10:00am in the Town Council Chambers at 525 San Anselmo Avenue.
