

**Minutes**  
**San Anselmo Historical Commission Meeting**

Discussion Items/Unfinished Business:

1. Oral History Project: No report. Judy suggested a possible candidate who lives on San Francisco Blvd.
2. Collections/ Database/ Acquisitions/ Research Projects:
  - a. Acquisitions: Platform scale donated by Renee Kientz has been restored and returned to the Museum. The cost was \$245.00.  
A woman in Maryland has Little League photos from the 1950s and 1960s and is sending them as well as class photos from Isabel Cook.  
Antone Sousa is planning to donate some of his personal collection to the museum and shared the physical samples of 1) a vintage firebox, 2) a fire bell, 3) a presentation bugle, 5) Antone's dad's chiefs hat, 6) a fireman's hat, 7) brass nozzles, and other items. Thank you Antone!
  - b. Judy's research discovered that 128 Tunstead used to be the location of the San Anselmo Herald circa 1915
  - c. Rick and Judy are working on signage for the Patterson Bridge, based on Rick's research.
  - d. Copy of Barry Spitz's book on San Anselmo came from the Friends of the Library.
3. Publication of Historical Walk: Alan is out but Judy will connect with him to suggest he provide a script to several people.
4. Downtown and Seminary Walking Tours will start up again April 27<sup>th</sup>. It was agreed to use Eventbrite for signups. Rick will post a flyer on Next Door when it is ready.
5. Hallway Displays: Currently a gardening display and waiting on Cedars information for a future exhibit.
6. Historical Society Program: Still looking for a speaker but discussed Brian Crawford's talk on Shipwrecks of Marin as a good program. Looking into a date in May.
7. Review of Project List for 2019: Annual downtown photoshoot is currently in process and everything else is covered.
8. Museum Docent Schedule: All shifts are covered.
