San Anselmo Historical Commission Meeting
January 15, 2020

Judy Coy convened the meeting of the members of the San Anselmo Historical Commission at 7:30 pm on January 15, 2020.

Financial Report: Carol reported that the current balance is \$18,583.85 in the Society account. Several donations and one new membership were received over the prior month.

Discussion Items/Unfinished Business:

1. Oral History Project: No report.
2. Collections / Acquisitions/ Research Projects:
Projects: Judy is working on getting the backlog of items and photos cataloged. She is working on Kientz and Craemer donations and will then start work on the Staley postcard collection and Antone's donations.
Donations: Carol brought in a map of San Anselmo from 1978, a donation from Jeff Craemer. In addition, Jeff donated a photograph of the Torrance Gallery circa 1960 along with the actual letters from the building signage. Jeff also donated some photographs of an unidentified drive-in.
Purchases: Judy purchased the following for the collection: two photo postcards of Geneva Hall circa 1953 from eBay, photo of view of San Anselmo Avenue ca. 1940's and two Drake High School yearbooks (1990 and 1992).
Research Projects: Judy is looking into San Anselmo dairy locations to help Mike Moyle with his dairy identification project.
Diorama: Mary Miner is continuing her work; she plans to ramp up in the new year.
3. VoiceMap Historical Walk: Judy reported in Alan Cascio's absence that there are a couple of small corrections to be made. The walk is currently priced at \$4.99 and, after discussion, commissioners felt that the price should be lowered to \$1.99. The item will be discussed again in February.
4. Walking Tours: no tours currently planned.
5. Hallway Displays: Cedars has removed their display materials. Judy is preparing a display to celebrate the Centennial of the Women's Vote which will go up soon and remain up through June.
6. Museum Docent Schedule: All shifts are covered.
