

**MINUTES**  
**TOWN OF SAN ANSELMO**  
**ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT COMMITTEE MEETING**  
**Town Council Chambers, 525 San Anselmo Avenue, San Anselmo**  
**February 11, 2020, 8:45 a.m.**

**Call to Order:** Chair Ginsberg called the meeting to order at 8:45 a.m.

**Approval of Meeting Minutes:** M/s Warner/Cico to approve the January 14, 2020, minutes, carried unanimously.

**Open Time for Public Expression:** Town Council Member Colbert reported that the Transportation Agency of Marin (TAM) board voted to support the SMART train ballot measure but he and Supervisor Rice voted no. He provided his reasoning. Colbert reported that they are considering congestion as it relates to the trial Richmond-San Rafael Bridge bike lane. Cico invited everyone to the Chamber of Commerce State of the Town 2020 Thursday, February 27, from 12:00 p.m. - 1:30 p.m. with guest speaker Supervisor Katie Rice. Ginsberg mentioned that some restaurants are moving towards take out/delivery only models and Cico noted that Chamber members have expressed concern with the fees and data use for restaurant delivery services.

**Update from Subcommittee Reviewing Vacancies and Uses** Warner reported on the property owner surveys. She requested contact information for property owners.

**Update on Wayfinding Signage and Red Hill Median Landscape** Schneider indicated the median on Red Hill is nearing completion. Public Works is installing the first phase of large signs. Condry will make a map for the web site where people can pull up images of the signs.

**Economic Development Plan Action Items for 2019-2020** – The EDC reviewed the Action Plan. Staff will use the notice cabinet at San Anselmo and Center Boulevard near the market or will remove the cabinet.

**What's New in San Anselmo Business** Colbert reported that the bookstore at 615 San Anselmo Avenue is for sale and someone is interested in partnering with someone with bookstore operating experience. It was suggested that Book Passage may be a successful partner. Madge & Me Hats has opened at 506 San Anselmo Avenue.

**Requests for Future Agenda Items** the EDC will begin with Action Items 2, 3 and 4 at the next meeting and will select the Chair and Vice Chair at the March 2020 meeting.
