

**Minutes**  
**San Anselmo Historical Commission Meeting**  
**February 19, 2020**

Financial Report: Judy reported for Carol Acquaviva that the current balance is \$18,626.48 in the Society account. Judy reported that she will be submitting receipts totaling approximately \$425.00

Discussion Items/Unfinished Business:

1. Oral History Project: No report.
2. Collections / Acquisitions/ Research Projects:  
Collections: Judy has been busy cataloging. She finished the Staley postcard collection and a large part of Antone Sousa's donations. She also catalogued a purchase of matchbook covers which included some of Antone's.  
Acquisitions: Sleepy Hollow cookbook from 1986. Judy was contacted by someone who wanted to donate a play (script) by Joan R. Brady, a former resident of San Anselmo, and Judy accepted the donation.  
Purchases: Negative of power station/ water tank. Date unknown; three postcards of Sleepy Hollow circa 1918 of Butterfield Road, View looking down on San Anselmo, and train trestle by White Hill School.  
Research: A student from Drake came to the museum to research Archie Williams, a former teacher at Drake who also ran in the 1936 Olympics.
3. Diorama and timeline enhancements: Timeline enhancements are coming soon, and Mary Miner is working with Antone's son Brian to finish the pieces for the diorama.
4. VoiceMap Historical Walk: Alan will lower the price to \$1.99 for the tour as well as look into making minor changes to the content of the walk. Once complete, advertising will include flyers, Town news, and NextDoor.
5. Walking Tours: Downtown tours start in April and Seminary tours start in May. There are also possible school tours coming up.
6. Museum Docent Schedule: All shifts are covered.
7. New Business:  
Kentfield/Greenbrae Historical Society event is coming up May 2<sup>nd</sup>. Dick volunteered to cover it and Antone will be asked to join him.  
Projects for 202 : Eileen volunteered to do a section of the downtown photoshoot; the Historical Society program will be discussed at the March meeting.
