1. **Meeting Called to Order at 7:02 PM**

5. **Parks Report**
 - a. Public Works will begin work on the path from the tennis courts to the Log Cabin.
 - b. Marin Sanitary is picking up trash twice weekly at Memorial Park.
 - c. Grass is very dry on fields due to drought. Fields will be watered a few times in the next few weeks to break up the soil for soccer practices.
6. **Presentations**
 - a. **San Anselmo Live – Mattie O’Grady** - The Recreation Department is partnering with the Chamber of Commerce to put on an 8-week series of concerts downtown at the Town Hall Plaza and at Creek Park. Music will be Fridays and Saturdays with a variety of bands, children’s music, jazz, and youth bands. *O’Grady* is working on an alternative event to replace 2021 Country Fair Day in the evening on September 25th. The event will be “Art and Music on the Avenue”.
 - b. **Fall updates – Mattie O’Grady** – Recreation is slowly going back to programs that have been modified since the pandemic. Robson Aftercare, Gymnastics, 23 Elephants, and Art Classes are resuming at full capacity. The Fall guide is online. After school enrichment is running but at a smaller scale than before. We are only able to offer afterschool enrichment classes outdoors on RVSD property due to COVID restrictions.
7. **Discussion Items**
 - a. **Park Clean-up projects** – *Kerr* to see if Troop 50 wants to participate. *Wu* to gather volunteers and set up groups to meet for projects to clean up around the park. *Overaa* to recruit high school students to participate.
 - b. **Memorial Park Updates** – Instead of painting the play structure it will be stained. It will last longer and is easier to maintain.
