

May 23rd 1907

The regularly adjourned meeting of the Board of Trustees of the Town of San Anselmo was called to order at 8-14 P. M. Pres. H. E. Jones presiding.

There were present at the meeting the following trustees: - Sindsy, Lrisp, Rabiner & Jones. Trustee Taylor being absent.

The minutes of the meeting of May 16th were approved as read by the clerk.

A communication from Mr L. S. Wall with a check attached to apply on street lights was read by the clerk.

Motion by Trustee Sindsy seconded by Rabiner that the check be mailed to the San Rafael Gas & Elect. Co. to apply on account. Motion carried.

Two communications were read from the Marin Co. Water Co. One in reference to leakage from the sprinkling wagon and one asking for a report of the quantity of water used during April.

Trustee Sindsy of the Street Com. presented a verbal report in reference to the installation of hydrants for water wagon and for fire use. The committee was granted further time.

Motion by Trustee Sindsy seconded by Lrisp that the bridge on Madrone Ave. be repaired at a cost not to

exceed \$35.⁰⁰ Motion carried.

A resolution was presented by Trustee
 Erisp to amend Ordinance # 6 entitled
 An Ordinance Regulating the Sale of Liquors
 passed April 25th 1907 as follows.

By adding to said ordinance the
 following. The provisions of this ordinance
 shall not apply to the sale of vinous or
 malt liquors in original packages by
 merchants doing business within the corporate
 limits of the Town of San Anselmo and
 carrying a regular line of groceries and
 provisions, after having first procured a
 license from the Board of Town Trustees
 so to do; Provided that no liquor shall
 be consumed upon the premises or shall be
 carried away by the purchaser, it being
 understood that the delivery of the liquor
 at the residence of the purchaser by the
 seller shall constitute the sale thereof.

That the rate of license for the
 above privilege shall be and the same
 is hereby fixed at the sum of Twenty-five
 {25.00} dollars for three months.

Motion by Trustee Erisp seconded
 by Sundry that the resolution be adopted.
 The trustees voted as follows.

Motion by Trustee Crisp seconded by Roubinger that the Town Attorney be directed to draft an ordinance as provided by the resolution. Motion carried.

Motion by Trustee Lindsey seconded by Crisp that the Recorder be authorized to purchase the necessary books and supplies pertaining to his office. Motion carried.

Motion Trustee Crisp seconded by Lindsey that the Marshall be instructed to order a certain Mr Gonzalez to stop selling liquor within the township and to place him under arrest if he refused. Motion carried.

Motion Trustee Crisp seconded by Lindsey that the meeting adjourn. Motion carried. Adjournment 8-53 P.M.
