The regularly adjourned meeting of the Board of Trustees of the Town of San Anselmo was called to order at 8-14 P. M. Chairman H. C. Jones presiding.

There were present at the meeting the following trustees. Lindsey, Rabiner and Jones. Trustees Crisp and Taylor being absent.

The minutes of the meeting of June 6<sup>th</sup> were approved as read by the clerk.

Under the head of communications the following were read: - from F. B. Blake in reference to the filling in of a certain creek bed and backing up the water on certain lots in the Rose Valley Park Tract. No action taken as this matter was being handled by the Sanitary Board. From Frederick Croker in reference to installing a watering place for horses and dogs. Referred to the Street Com. From the Marin Improvement Assn. an expression of appreciation for the passing of a pound ordinance. From Mrs. Hyne requesting permission to cut down two trees that were obstructing the roadway. Referred to the Street Com.

Under the head of Com. reports Trustee Lindsey reported progress in reference to the installing of lights. Trustee Rabiner reported progress in

reference to installing of hydrants.

Motion by Trustee Lindsey seconded by Raubinger that Ordinance # 11 entitled "Providing for the sale of intoxicating liquors and regulating the sale thereof" be passed and approved. The trustees voted as follows.
