

July 11th 1907

The regularly adjourned meeting of the Board of Trustees of the Town of San Anselmo was called to order at 8-15 P. M. chairman Jones presiding.

There were present at the meeting the following trustees. Lindsey, Lirish, Ranbinger, Taylor and Jones.

The minutes of the meetings of June 13th and July 5th were approved as read by the clerk.

A petition for a license to sell liquor was presented by Jean Gazeaux and was read by the clerk.

Mr Hoag presented a corrected map of the Bush Tract.

A petition from the Fire Department Committee of the San Anselmo Improvement Club asking for the sanction of the Board in reference to its plans for a volunteer fire department and the raising of funds for the same was read.

Motion by Trustee Lindsey seconded by Taylor that this committee be recognized as the organizers of a regular volunteer fire department. Motion carried.

Motion by Trustee Taylor seconded by Ranbinger that the map of the Bush Tract as presented by Mr Hoag be recognized as the official map of the district and that all roads as shown be accepted. Motion carried.

A report of Treasurer J. B. Jones.

for the quarter ending June 30th 1907
was presented and read.

Mr Stetherton of the Marin Co. Horticultural Society addressed the Board and urged the assistance of the Board in the matter of the prevention of mutilation and destruction of trees. He also offered young trees for planting along the main road.

Mr Sinsley of the Street Committee reported that the Water Co. was installing seven hydrants for the use of the sprinkling wagon.

Mr Taylor of the Public Health and Safety Com. reported that nothing had been done by the owners of the Dance Hall to comply with the provisions of the ordinance relating to "Exits".

The following ordinances were presented and read. #12 entitled - "An ordinance to provide for the licensing of business carried on in the Town of San Anselmo for the purpose of revenue and regulation".

#13 entitled - Relating to the impounding of dogs, etc.

#14 entitled - Pertaining to the tacking of signs, etc.

#15 entitled - A few ordinance

Motion by Trustee Sinsley seconded by Taylor that the following bills be allowed and paid.

Motion by Trustee Taylor seconded
by Sindsy that the Trustees be empowered
to lease the present meeting place of
the Board for a term of 2 years and
10 months dating from July 1st 1907
and to raise money to place same
in condition for the post-office and a
meeting place for the board. Motion
carried.

The Street Committee was ordered
to report back at the next meeting
in reference to the purchase of a
sprinkling wagon.

Motion by Trustee Sindsy seconded
by Crisp that the meeting adjourn to
meet Thursday evening July 18th 1907.
Motion carried. Adjournment 9:44.
