

July 25th 1907

The regularly adjourned meeting of the Board of Trustees of the Town of San Anselmo was called to order at 8-10 P. M. chairman W. E. Jones presiding. There were present at the meeting the following trustees, Lindsey, Crisp, Raubinger, Taylor & Jones.

The minutes of the meetings of July 11th & 18th were approved as read by the clerk.

The following applications for permits to sell liquor were presented and read, San Anselmo Merchandise Co., Mary Needham, Jean Clazeaux & James Rossi.

A motion by trustee Crisp seconded by Lindsey that a license be granted the San Anselmo Merchandise Co. Motion carried.

A motion by trustee Raubinger seconded by Taylor that a license be granted Mary Needham. Motion carried.

Licenses were denied James Rossi and Jean Clazeaux as same did not conform to Ordinance # 11 regulating the sale of intoxicating liquor.

A communication was read from E. B. Martmelli stating that the owner of the San Anselmo Lance Hall was making the necessary alterations to the hall to make it conform to the Town Ordinance regulating such.

The communication was referred to the Public Health & Safety Com.

Under the head of reports of committees the Street Com. reported that the Marin Co. Water Co. had on hand 6 hydrants which they could immediately install.

A motion by Trustee Crisp seconded by Sindsy that the Clerk be authorized to advertise for bids for the purchase and installation of 6 standard pattern hydrants. Motion carried.

A motion by Trustee Sindsy seconded by Crisp that the Clerk be authorized to advertise for bids for a 600 gal. sprinkling wagon. Motion carried.

The Clerk was instructed to notify a certain camping party to stop the throwing of rubbish and refuse in the creek.

A motion by Trustee Taylor seconded by Crisp that Ordinance #16 entitled "Concerning Fire Marshall and the Protection of the Town against Fire" be passed and approved. The Trustees voted as follows.

Aye - Sindsy, Crisp, Rabiner, Taylor & Jones.
Nays - None. Motion carried.

A motion by Trustee Taylor seconded by Rabiner that Ordinance #17 entitled "Providing for the Protection of Trees"

be passed and approved. The Trustees voted as follows.

Aye - Sindsay, Crisp, Raubinger, Taylor & Jones.
Noes - None. Motion carried.

A motion by Trustee Raubinger seconded by Crisp that Ordinance # 18 entitled "Regulating the Speed of Motor Vehicles and Bicycles" be passed and approved. The Trustees voted as follows.

Aye - Sindsay, Crisp, Raubinger, Taylor & Jones.
Noes - None. Motion carried.

A motion by Trustee Crisp seconded by Raubinger that Ordinance # 19 entitled "Regulating the Salaries of Officials" be passed and approved. The Trustees voted as follows.

Aye - Sindsay, Crisp, Raubinger, Taylor & Jones.
Noes - None - Motion carried.

An application for a license to sell liquor was presented by Vanderhede & Wingst.

Motion by Trustee Taylor seconded by Crisp that the license be granted. Motion carried.

Motion by Trustee Crisp seconded by Sindsay that the Public Health and Safety Com. be empowered to have the present meeting place of the Board altered and fitted up at a cost not to exceed \$100⁰⁰ Motion carried.

Motion by Trustee Taylor seconded by Raubinger that the Finance Com. make a complete report at the next meeting as to the disbursements and the contemplated expenditures of the Board. Motion carried.

Motion Trustee Crisp seconded by Lindsey that the meeting adjourn to meet Tuesday evening July 30th 07. Motion carried. Adjournment 9-03
