

September 5th 1907

The regular monthly meeting of the Board of Trustees of the Town of San Anselmo was called to order at 8-34 P. M. Pres. W. C. Jones presiding.

The roll call was as follows:-
Present - Trustees Crisp, Rabiner & Jones.
Absent - Lindsey & Taylor.

The minutes of Aug. 15th were approved as read.

Town Attorney Boyd reported that a State law was in effect whereby the property owners adjoining the two obstructed water courses in question in the Township could be compelled to fill in the same.

A motion by Trustee Rabiner seconded by Crisp that the Town Attorney notify all the property owners to take immediate steps for filling in these sinks. Motion carried.

A motion by Trustee Crisp seconded by Rabiner that Ordinance #21 entitled "Relating to the Licensing of Bowling Alleys" be passed and approved. The vote was as follows.

Aye - Crisp, Rabiner & Jones.

Absent - Lindsey & Taylor.

Noes - None. Motion carried.

The following ordinances were presented and read.

Ordinance #22 entitled "Relating

to Street Work and the Removal of Gravel and other Surface Dressings from Streets.

Ordinance #23 entitled "Relating to the Interference with Fire Hydrants"

Ordinance #24 entitled "Relating to the Carrying of Concealed Weapons."

Motion by Trustee Crisp seconded by Rabiner that the Town Attorney be authorized to draft an Ordinance amending Ordinance #11 to allow hotels and restaurants to serve liquor with meals. Motion carried.

Upon reconsideration of the bids of Punnett Bros. and House & Yarey a motion was made by Trustee Rabiner seconded by Crisp that the bid of Punnett Bros. of \$150⁰⁰ for the making of a Township Map be accepted. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Trustee Crisp seconded by Rabiner and carried that the following bills be allowed for payment.
