Messrs H. N. Plumber and A. J. Clakely representing the Fairfax Water Co. appeared before the Board and presented maps showing the company holdings and the proposed pipe line and offered to supply the Town for its own distribution, water at the following rate per day.

200,000 or over	"	15¢	"	"
