The following resolution was presented by Trustee Crisp.

"Resolution declaring certain standing water to be a public nuisance etc."

Whereas it has come to the notice of the Board of Trustees of the Town of San Anselmo that a certain lot of land owned by me ——— is submerged in standing water which if allowed to remain will become stagnant and be a public menace and endanger the health of the community, be it,

Resolved that the same be and it is hereby declared a public nuisance by said Board of Trustees and be it further,

Resolved that in order to further the public welfare and protect the health of the community at large, the Marshall of said Town be and

he is hereby instructed to order the owner of said property to forthwith remove such nuisance under penalty of fine or imprisonment, or both and be it further,

Resolved that this resolution be spread upon the minutes and a copy served on said ——— by the Marshall.
