The Board of Trustees of the Town of San Anselmo held a regularly adjourned meeting this date. Pres. W. E. Jones called the meeting to order at 9 P. M. with all members present. Trustee Crisp, Ranbringer, Ashworth, Robinson & Jones.

The reading of the minutes was dispensed with.

A communication from the League of California Municipalities was read.

Upon motion duly carried the communication was laid over to the next meeting.

The report of Mr John W. Leary Architect on the condition of "Pioneer Hall" was read.

Trustee Crisp moved that Pioneer Hall be condemned and that no more public assemblages of any nature be allowed in said hall until all the changes, alterations, and improvements as set forth in Mr J. W. Leary's report were made. Trustee Ashworth seconded the motion which was carried.

The clerk was instructed to immediately notify Mr Chas. Shelton owner of the hall as to the action

of the Board.

After the second reading of Ordinance # 31 entitled "Relating to the Licensing of Peddlers, Solicitors, and other Agents, Amending Ordinance # 20 of the Board of Trustees of the Town of San Anselmo. it was adopted by the following vote.

After the second reading of Ordinance # 32 entitled Amending Ordinance # 26 of the Board of Trustees of the Town of San Anselmo it was adopted by the following vote.

Nays. None.

The following Ordinances were presented for first reading  
# 33 entitled "Relating to the Removal of Grass and Weeds from Sidewalks and Gutterways".

# 34 entitled "Establishing Water Rates for the Marin County Water Co."

Trustee Ashworth moved the adoption of the following resolution.

Whereas, when the Town of San Anselmo first was incorporated, it was, and would be until November,

1907, without funds with which to pay and discharge its current running expenses: and

Whereas, the Marin County Bank honored and cashed, in advance, the warrants of said Town, and thereby enabled it to pay its current expenses: -

Now, therefore, be it resolved: That the Board of Trustees of the Town of San Anselmo extend to the officers of said bank a vote of thanks for their kindness and courtesy shown by them to the Town of San Anselmo.

Be it further resolved: That this resolution be spread upon the minutes of the Board, and a copy thereof mailed to said Marin County Bank.

Trustee Rabinqu moved that the roads as shown on the map of Amended Map of that portion of Glenwood Tract formerly known as lot 1 of the Rosenthal Tract be not accepted by the Board. Trustee Ashworth seconded the motion which was duly carried.

Trustee Rabinqu moved that the meeting adjourn to meet Thursday evening, June 25<sup>th</sup> 1908. Trustee Ashworth seconded the motion

which was duly carried.
