

June 20th 1908

A special called meeting of the Board of Trustees of the Town of San Anselmo was held in the Town Hall this date and was called to order at 5 o'clock P. M. by Pres. H. E. Jones. Four members of the Board were present. Trustees Ashworth, Rabiner, Robinson & Jones. Trustee Crisp absent.

Trustee Rabiner moved: That Father Egan and the Catholic Church be granted the special privilege of holding services in Pioneer Hall on Sunday June 21st. That in view of the fact that said Pioneer Hall had been condemned at the Board meeting held June 17th the Board of Trustees of the Town of San Anselmo would not be held liable in any manner for any accident or calamity owing to the use of the Hall for the services. That the services be held entirely at their own risk. That the granting of this permission did not alter the duty of the Board to alter the building in accordance with the plans presented by John H. Carey Architect.

Trustee Ashworth seconded the motion which was carried.
