

June 27th 1908

A regularly adjourned meeting of the Board of Trustees of the Town of San Anselmo was held in the Town Hall this date and was called to order at 5 o'clock P. M. by Pres. W. E. Jones.

All members of the board were present. Trustees Crisp, Rarbinga, Ashworth, Robinson & Jones.

Trustee Ashworth moved: That in view of the fact that all the alterations and improvements to be made in Pioneer Hall as set forth in the report of John W. Wary Architect had been made, that the order condemning said hall be withdrawn and that hall be declared safe and fit for public meetings and gatherings.

Trustee Rarbinga seconded the motion which was carried.

After discussion and upon motion duly carried Trustee Jones was authorized to procure 1 Marshal star and 11 Deputy Marshal stars also 1 doz Sappars.

Trustee Ashworth moved that the meeting adjourn to meet Tuesday evening June 30th. Trustee Crisp seconded the motion which was carried.
