

March 19th 1909

The Board of Trustees of the Town of San Anselmo held a regular adjourned meeting in the Town Hall this date. Pres. W. E. Jones called the meeting to order at 8:45 P.M.

All members of the Board were present to wit: Trustees Ashworth, Crisp, Robinson, Trunstead & Jones.

The minutes of the meetings of Feb. 4-18-25 and Mar 4th were approved as read.

The following communication from Antonio F. Sousa was read:-

I hereby agree to furnish to the Town of San Anselmo blue rock from Bothin's quarry at the rate of \$4.25 per cubic yard, said rock to be delivered to any part of the Town of San Anselmo as directed.

Trustee Trunstead moved: That the Street Com. be given full power to act regarding filling in of chuck holes in the roads in accordance with the above bid.

Trustee Ashworth seconded the motion which duly carried.

Public discussion and comment.

Mr John W. Adoo spoke against the proposed Bond issue of \$50,000⁰⁰.

A general discussion followed regarding the Bond issue, road repair and general improvements during which Mr. Bowick, Mr J. J. Taylor, Trustees Jones & Trunstead were the principal speakers.

No committee reports.

Trustee Robinson moved seconded by Crisp that the following bill be passed for payment. Motion carried.

In accordance with the resolution adopted at the meeting of Mar. 4th the bid of the Pacific Gas & Elect. Co. accompanied by a certified check for \$1387 was presented.

The bid in substance was as follows: To furnish and maintain and keep in good order and repair, all necessary poles, wires, lamps and other apparatus required for lighting by electricity the streets and highways of the Town of San Anselmo, and to furnish the electric current for, and cause to be lighted every night and all night during the term of 5 years beginning on the 19th day of April 1909, 9-7 $\frac{1}{2}$ ampere alternating current series arc lights, each consuming not less than 475 watts, and commonly known as of 2000 candle power, commercially rated, and 166 incandescent electric lights commercially rated at 20 candle power each for the sum of \$2736⁰⁰ each year during said term of five years in twelve equal monthly installments.

Trustee Ashworth moved: That the Board of Trustees in behalf of the people of the Town of San Anselmo accept the bid of the Pacific Gas & Elect. Co.

the original copy to be kept on file and that the President and the Clerk be authorized to execute the contract for and on behalf of the Town of San Anselmo.

Trustee Crisp seconded the motion. The motion carried by the following vote.

Aye: Trustead, Robinson, Ashworth, Crisp & Jones.
Noes - None.

Trustee Ashworth moved seconded by Trustead that the meeting adjourn. Motion carried.
