

- April 2nd 1909 -

The regular monthly meeting of the Board of Trustees of the Town of San Anselmo, was called to order at 8:50 P.M. by President W. E. Jones.

There were present, -
Trustees: Ashworth, Crisp, Robinson, Linstead and Jones.

The minutes of the meetings of March 19th and April 1st were approved as read.

A petition signed by a number of residents in the Sunnyside District complaining against the leaving of vehicles of various natures and the piling of other unrightly debris along the side of a certain road in that district was presented and read.

Trustee Crisp moved, seconded by Ashworth that the Marshal act in regard to the above petition. Motion carried.

A communication from Charles R. Wilson asking permission to build a foot-bridge at his own expense across San Anselmo Creek on Madrone Avenue was read. Trustee Ashworth moved, seconded by Crisp, that the communication be referred to the Chairman of the Street Committee with full power to act. Motion carried.

Public discussion and comment.

Many speeches were made regarding the proposed Bond election.

Trustee Cripp presented for first reading Ordinance #43 entitled, "Amending Ordinance #2 Designating the regular meeting of the Board of Trustees."

Trustee Schwartz presented the following Resolution and moved its adoption.

"Resolved: That the Clerk of said Town be, and he is hereby, authorized and directed to advertise for sealed bids for furnishing the Town of San Anselmo, by the day, with two (2) teams of horses and two (2) drivers for sprinkling the streets during the hours of from six o'clock A.M. to Ten o'clock A.M., and from Two (2) o'clock to Six o'clock P.M., upon such streets and days, during the year 1909, as the Street Committee may direct, and that said teams and drivers shall be subject to the orders of the Fire Department at all times.

Said bids to be opened in open session of this Board, at the hour of 8 o'clock P.M. on Monday, the 19th day of April, 1909, and the Clerk is hereby directed to advertise for said Bids by posting for at

least two (2) weeks in four (4) of the most public places in said town."

Trustee Crisp seconded the motion which carried by the following vote:

Trustee Ashworth moved, seconded by Crisp, that the meeting adjourn to meet.
