

- April 19th 1909 -

A regularly adjourned meeting of the Board of Trustees of the Town of San Anselmo was held this date in the Town Hall. President W. E. Jones called the meeting to order at 9:05 P.M. with Trustees Crisp, Robinson and Jones present. Absent, Trustees Ashworth and Tunstead.

The minutes of the meeting of April 2nd were read and approved.

Wrag & Parisdale, in a communication dated April 19th requested permission to cut down several small trees and brush on the West side of Saunders Avenue between the railroad right of way and the bridge at San Anselmo Creek, which permission was granted on motion of Trustee Robinson, seconded by Crisp and duly carried.

A representative of the Sunset Magazine addressed the Board and outlined a plan for advertising of San Anselmo and Marin County. Trustee Robinson moved: That the Board authorize the expenditure of \$15⁰⁰ per month for a period of one year for the privilege of a full page Ad in Sunset Magazine. Seconded by Trustee Crisp and duly carried.

Ordinance #43 entitled, Amending Ordinance #2 Designating the regular meeting of the Board of Trustees was given its second reading and was adopted as an Ordinance of the Town of San Anselmo by the following vote:-

Aye: Robinson, Crisp and Jones.

Noes: None -

Absent: Trustees Tunstead and Ashworth.

Trustee Crisp moved, seconded by Robinson and duly carried that the streets, lanes, avenues, roads and highways lying

and being in the corporate limits of the town of San Anselmo, Marin County, and delineated on a map presented by H. F. Mann be not accepted.

In accordance with the resolution passed April 2nd the Clerk opened in public meeting and read the following bids for furnishing two (2) teams for sprinkling as specified in said resolution:

Holz Gumber & Supply Co. -	\$ 6.00 per day.
Antonio F. Souza -	5.75 " "
Schulken Bus -	5.50 " "
J. Fommesbeck -	5.45 " "

Trustee Robinson moved, seconded by Criss and duly carried that owing to the absence of the members of the Street Committee that awarding of the contract be postponed until Friday evening, April 23rd and that the Board instruct M. Fommesbeck to have sprinkling wagon started immediately at the price of \$5.45 per day until such time as contract was awarded.

Trustee Robinson moved, seconded by Criss and duly carried, that the meeting adjourn to meet Friday evening April 23rd. Adjournment 9:15 P.M.
