

- April 23 - 1909 -

A regularly adjourned meeting of the Board of Trustees of the Town of San Anselmo was held this date in the Town Hall. President W. E. Jones called the meeting to order at 9:10 P.M. with Trustees Crisp, Robinson, Tunstead and Jones present. Absent, Trustee Ashworth.

The minutes of the meeting of April 19th were approved as read.

Trustee Tunstead called for a re-reading of the resolution passed April 2nd calling for bids for road sprinkling. The Clerk read the resolution after which Trustee Tunstead asked for a written opinion from the Town Attorney as to its legality.

The bids submitted and read at the meeting of April 19th were re-read by the Clerk.

Trustee Robinson moved: That the bid of \$5.45 per day submitted by J. Honnebeck be accepted. No second to the motion.

Trustee Crisp moved, seconded by Tunstead, that all bids be rejected and that new bids be called for.

The vote by roll call resulted:-

Aye: Tunstead and Crisp.

No: Robinson and Jones.

Absent: Ashworth. Motion lost.

Trustee Crisp moved, seconded by Robinson and duly carried, that the question of bids for sprinkling be laid over until the next regular meeting.

Dr. Jones of the Citizens Street Committee reported progress and asked for more time so that the condition of the roads might be further looked into. A

general discussion followed.

Trustee Crisp moved, seconded by
Sunstead, that the meeting adjourn. Motion
carried.
