

June 28th 1919 -

The Board of Trustees of the Town of San Anselmo held a regularly adjourned meeting in the Town Hall this date. The meeting was called to order at 9 P.M. by President W.E. Jones with Trustee Ashworth, Crisp and Jones present. Trustee Tunstead and Robinson absent.

There being no objections the reading of the minutes of the meeting of June 14th was dispensed with.

The application for a permit for a liquor license from Salvatore Barvello was considered and was granted by the following vote, upon motion of Trustee Ashworth, seconded by Crisp:-

Aye: Ashworth, Crisp and Jones.

Noes: None.

Absent: Tunstead and Robinson.

Trustee Ashworth presented the following resolution and moved its adoption. Seconded by Trustee Crisp.

Whereas there is danger in the promiscuous discharge of fireworks in the Town of San Anselmo at the coming celebration of the Fourth of July, except on the County Road in front of the Station at San Anselmo; And whereas it is to the mutual interest of all the residents to see to it that no fireworks are discharged at any other place other than hereinbefore designated. Now therefore be it resolved that it is the sense of this Board that no fireworks be discharged except in front of the said station and be it further resolved that all residents take it upon themselves to see to it that this resolution is respected and its provisions

Complied with.
