The Board of Trustees of the Town of San Anselmo held a regularly adjourned meeting in the Town Hall, this date. President W. E. Jones called the meeting to order at 8:50 P.M.

The reading of the minutes was dispensed with.

The Committee of ten composed of Messrs. Rosenthal, Jones, Kemp, Van Orden, McAdoo, Throck, Whitney, Sturdivant, Walsh and Stratford appointed by the Board to investigate the condition of the roads and to suggest a remedy for their poor condition, reported in a communication dated July 6th recommending a bond issue of not more than \$40,000.⁰⁰
