

August 6th 1909

The Board of Trustees of the Town of San Anselmo held a regularly adjourned meeting in the Town Hall this date. Pres. W. E. Jones called the meeting to order at 9 P.M. There were present Trustees Ashworth, Crisp and Jones.

Absent: Trustees Tunstead and Robinson.

Owing to the absence of Clerk A. A. Moore Trustee Crisp was appointed Clerk pro-tem.

Ordinance # 48 entitled: "Calling and providing for a special election to be held on Thursday, the 31st day of August, 1909, in Sewer District #1 of the Town of San Anselmo, County of Marin, State of California, as divided and constituted by Ordinance No. 47 passed and adopted August 5th, 1909, to submit to the qualified voters residing within said Sewer District #1 the proposition of incurring bonded indebtedness of the Town of San Anselmo, to pay for certain municipal improvements, namely: The building, construction, extension and completion of a Sewer System for said Sewer District No. 1." was introduced and given its first reading.

Upon motion duly carried the meeting adjourned.
