

November 22nd 1909.

The Board of Trustees of the Town of San Anselmo met in regular adjourned session in the Town Hall this date.

Pres. W. E. Jones called the meeting to order at 8.25 P. M.

Present - Trustees Stratford, Trustead, Robinson & Jones.

Absent - Trustee Crisp.

The reading of the minutes was dispensed with.

Fourteen residents and property holders in the vicinity of the quarry operated by the Marin Rock Co. presented a petition to the Board protesting against the blasting and other unusual noises connected with its operation. The petition was read by the clerk and ordered placed on file.

Trustee Trustead moved seconded by Stratford. That the entire Board act as a committee to investigate the charges referred to in the petition and that definite action be deferred until the next regular monthly meeting. Motion carried.

After the second reading of Ordinance #56 entitled "An ordinance to provide for the licensing of business carried on in the Town of San Anselmo, for the purpose of regulation of said business". Trustee Stratford moved that same be adopted as an Ordinance of the Town of San Anselmo. The motion was seconded by Trustee Trustead and carried by the following vote.

Aye - Trustees Stratford, Trustead, Robinson & Jones.

Noes - None.

Absent - Trustee Crisp.

The motion to adjourn was made by Trustee Stratford, seconded by Trustee and carried.
