

January 31st 1910

The Board of Trustees of the Town of San Anselmo met in regular adjourned session in the Town Hall this date.

The meeting was called to order at 8-15 P. M. by Pres. W. E. Jones.

There were present: Trustees Junstead, Robinson Stratford, Whisp and Jones.

This being the time fixed by the order of the Board of Trustees for the receipt of bids for the purchase of the bonds of the Town of San Anselmo to the amount of Forty three thousand, five hundred dollars (\$43,500⁰⁰) for roads, and Fifteen thousand dollars (\$15,000⁰⁰) for sewers in Sewer District No. 1 of the Town of San Anselmo, and the bid therefor having been received, the same was opened in the presence of the Board and read by the Clerk, which said bid is in the words and figures following to-wit:

Dear Sir:-

For the \$43,500⁰⁰ San Anselmo Road Bonds of the denomination of \$500⁰⁰ each, dated October 1, 1909, and due \$1500 on October 1 in each of the years 1910 to 1938 inclusive, bearing interest at the rate of 4½ per centum per annum payable April 1 and October 1 in each year, and --

For the \$15,000 San Anselmo Sewer Bonds of the denomination of \$150. each,

per centum per annum, payable semi-annually, and due \$750. each year 1910 to 1929 inclusive, we will pay you \$58,500 and accrued interest.

This bid is made with the understanding that we are to have the opinion of Messrs. Goodfellow & Ellis certifying that the above two issues of Bonds are legal, furnished without cost to us.

It is further understood that the above Bonds when prepared will be lithographed.
