

April 14th 1910

The Board of Trustees of the Town of San Anselmo met in regular session in the Town Hall this date. Pres. W. E. Jones called the meeting to order at 9 P. M.

There were present: Trustees Stratford, Robinson, Crisp and Jones.

Absent: Trustee Trunstead.

The minutes of the meeting of March 10th were approved as read.

A petition from certain property owners on Madrone Ave. with regard to lights, hydrants and the broken bridge was read and referred to the Street Com.

W. E. Mitchel made written application to the Board for a permit to sell liquor with meals at the San Anselmo Restaurant and Boarding House located in the Meago Bldg. San Anselmo and Mariposa Ave.

Thursday evening April 21st was set for the final hearing of the application.

The Bush Tract Improvement Assn. in a communication dated April 13th advised the Board that they were desirous of installing at their expense, substantial street and avenue sign boards at all corners and asked permission to do so.

Jos. P. Baloun addressed the Board and made the further request that the labor be furnished by the Town.

On motion of Trustee Stratford, seconded by Trustee Crisp and carried, the permission was granted and the labor to be furnished by the Town.

Ordinance #59 entitled: "Establishing Water Rates for the Marin Water and Power Co." was given its second reading.

Trustee Crisp moved: That Ord. #59 be passed and adopted as an ordinance.
