

May 26th 1910

The Board of Trustees of the Town of San Anselmo met in adjourned session this date.

Pres. W. E. Jones called the meeting to order at 8-30 P. M.

There were present Trustees Gagan, Schrader, Whitaker, Stratford and Jones.

The reading of the minutes was dispensed with.

Ordinance #62 entitled "Changing place of regular monthly meetings of the Board of Trustees" was given its second reading.

Trustee Schrader moved to adopt Ordinance #62 as an Ordinance of the Town of San Anselmo. Seconded by Trustee Stratford and carried by the following vote.

Ayes: Trustee Gagan, Schrader, Whitaker, Stratford and Jones.

Noes: None.

Absent: None.

The following Ordinances were presented and given their first reading.

No. 63 entitled "Providing specifications for the installation and operation of moving picture machines."

No. 64 entitled "Regulations to prevent the spread of disease."

No. 65 entitled "Regulating the establishment and maintenance of hospitals."

No. 66 entitled "Providing for toilets for grounds used or rented for camping purposes."

No. 67 entitled "Providing for the abatement of nuisances caused by the formation of stagnant pools."

No. 68 entitled "Defining what is a nuisance and empowering the Board of Health to abate and summarily destroy said nuisance."

Trustee Whitaker moved seconded by Stratford: That the time for reception of bids for the sale of \$15,000⁰⁰ Sewer Bonds be extended one (1) week. Motion carried.

A petition from W. L. Barnard asking for a license to operate a Moving Picture Show was read.

Trustee Gagan moved to lay same on the table. Seconded by Stratford and carried.

Trustee Gagan moved to rescind the liquor license heretofore granted to W. E. Mitchel. Seconded by Stratford and carried.

Trustee Stratford moved to adjourn to meet Thursday evening June 2nd 1910. Seconded by Gagan and carried.
