

June 10th 1910

The Board of Trustees of the Town of San Anselmo met in regular adjourned session in the Town Hall this date.

Pres. W. E. Jones called the meeting to order at 8-40 P. M.

The entire Board being present namely: Trustees Gagan, Schrader, Whitaker, Stratford and Jones.

Clerk A. A. Moore being absent the chair appointed Trustee Gagan Clerk pro-tem.

An Ordinance entitled "Calling and providing for a special election to be held in the Town of San Anselmo, on the 7th day of July, 1910, to submit to the qualified voters of said Town six (6) propositions for incurring a bonded indebtedness of said Town to pay for certain municipal improvements, namely: street work, the acquisition and construction of a certain public street, a concrete bridge, ground and site for a Town Hall, including buildings thereon, street sprinkling system, and fire apparatus, including electric fire alarm system" was introduced and given its first reading.

On motion of Trustee Whitaker seconded by Trustee Stratford, ^{and carried} the Board adjourned to meet Thursday evening June 16th 1910.
