

June 28th 1910

A regularly adjourned meeting of the Board of Trustees of the Town of San Anselmo was held on this 28th day of June 1910 at the meeting place of the Board in the Croke Bldg. on Ross Ave.

Pres. W. E. Jones called the meeting to order at 8-45 P. M.

There were present Trustees Gagan, Stratford and Jones.

Absent - Trustees Schrader and Whitaker.

Trustee Stratford introduced the following resolution and moved its adoption to-wit:

Whereas there is danger in the promiscuous discharge of fireworks in the Town of San Anselmo at the coming celebration of the Fourth of July except on the County Road in front of the station at San Anselmo; And Whereas it is to the mutual interest of all the residents to see to it that no fireworks are discharged at any other place other than hereinbefore designated;

Now therefore be it resolved that it is the sense of this Board that no fireworks be discharged except in front of the said station and be it further resolved; that all residents take it upon themselves to see to it that this Resolution is respected and its provisions complied with.

Trustee Gagan seconded the motion which carried by the following vote.

Ayes: Trustees Gagan, Stratford and Jones.

Noes: None.

Absent: Trustees Schrader and Whitaker.

Trustee Gagan moved to allow for payment by warrant on the Treasury the claim of P. Honnerbeck of \$204.³⁸ for sprinkling. Seconded by Trustee Stratford and carried.

Trustee Stratford moved to postpone
the time for reception of bids for the
\$15,000⁰⁰ Sewer Bond issue to July 5th 1910.

Seconded by Trustee Gagan and carried.

Trustee Stratford moved to adjourn
to meet Tuesday evening July 5th 1910.

Seconded by Trustee Gagan and carried.
