

January 4th 1911

The Board of Trustees of the Town of San Anselmo met this date in regular adjourned session at their usual meeting place designated by Ordinance.

Pres. W. E. Jones called the meeting to order at 8-55 P. M.

There were present Trustees Gagan, Stratford and Jones.

Absent Trustees Schrader & Whitaker.

The reading of the minutes was dispensed with.

An Ordinance entitled "Regulating the use of the public streets, roads and highways for the purpose of placing therein pipes and other conduits in supplying water, gas, electricity or other fluid for lighting purposes to the Town of San Anselmo and its inhabitants, and providing for damages and indemnity for damages" introduced and first read Dec. 29th 1910 was again read and approved and adopted as Ordinance No. 74 of the Town of San Anselmo by the following vote:

Ayes - Trustees Gagan, Stratford and Jones.

Noes - None.

Absent - Trustees Schrader & Whitaker.

An Ordinance entitled "Providing rules and regulations for installing, connecting, wiring or otherwise putting in place electrical wires, equipment or apparatus" introduced and first read Dec 29th 1910 was again read and approved and adopted as Ordinance No. 75 of the Town of San Anselmo by the following vote: -

Ayes - Trustees Gagan, Stratford

and Jones.

Moves - None.

Absent - Trustees Schrader and Whitaker.

An Ordinance entitled "Amending sections 6 and 7 of Ordinance No. 44, providing for the sale of intoxicating liquors, and regulating the traffic thereof, as amended by Ordinance No. 60, and adding two (2) new sections thereto to be known as sections 6½ and 7½" introduced and first read Dec. 29th 1910 was again read and approved and adopted as Ordinance No. 76 of the Town of San Anselmo by the following vote: -

Ayes - Trustees Gagan, Stratford and Jones.

Moves - None.

Absent - Trustees Schrader & Whitaker.

An Ordinance entitled "Providing rules and regulations for the construction and installation of chimneys, flues, smoke stacks, smoke pipes, fireplaces, etc." was introduced and given its first reading.

Trustee Gagan moved to allow the following bill for payment by warrant on the Treasurer. Seconded by Trustee Stratford and duly carried.
