

March 30th 1911

The Board of Trustees of the Town of San Anselmo met this date in regular adjourned session at their usual meeting place designated by Ordinance.

Due to the absence of Pres. W. E. Jones Trustee E. Schrader occupied the chair and called the meeting to order at 8-55 P.M.

There were present Trustees Gagan, Schrader, Whitaker and Stratford.

Absent - Pres. W. E. Jones.

The minutes of the meeting of March 16th 1911 were approved as read.

An Ordinance entitled "Establishing water rates for the Marin Water and Power Co." was introduced and given its first reading.

An Ordinance entitled "To provide for the removal of debris and unburned portions of buildings resulting from the destruction or partial destruction by fire of buildings upon lots, sidewalks and streets within the Town of San Anselmo; defining a nuisance, and providing for its abatement, and fixing a penalty for the violation thereof" introduced and first read March 23rd 1911 was upon motion duly made by Trustee Gagan, seconded by Trustee Stratford and carried laid over to April 6th 1911 for final consideration.

Trustee Stratford moved to adjourn to meet Thursday evening April 6th 1911. Secured by Trustee Gagan and duly carried. Adjournment 10 P.M.
