

May 25th 1911

The Board of Trustees of the Town of San Anselmo met this date in regular adjourned session at the Pioneer Hall located on the South side of Ross Ave.

The meeting was called to order at 8-45 P. M. Trustee Gagan presiding.

There were present Trustees Gagan, Schrader, Whitaker & Stratford.

Absent. Pres. H. E. Jones.

The minutes of the meetings of April 13th-19th and 20th were approved as read.

An Ordinance entitled "Changing time and place of regular monthly meetings of Board of Trustees" was introduced and given its first reading.

Geo. S. Williams in a communication dated May 25th 1911 made application for a permit or license to conduct a moving picture show in the store formerly occupied by Vonderhede & Wingst in the Pioneer Hall Bldg. located on Ross Ave. Same was laid over to the next meeting.

Trustee Stratford moved that the Clerk be authorized to draw a warrant in the sum of \$500⁰⁰ in favor of S. Nathan and against Municipal Improvement Fund No. 2 for the payment of two (2) horses for use in the Fire Dept. Seconded by Trustee Schrader and duly carried.

Trustee Schrader moved that Chas. Cartwright be appointed custodian of the fire house, Town hall and grounds at a salary of \$70.00 per month. Seconded by Trustee Stratford and duly carried.

After considerable discussion with regard to requiring Fred. Broken to file a bond for \$2000⁰⁰ before granting him permission to move his building over the new concrete bridge opposite the station Trustee Stratford moved that permission be granted provided Fred

Book filed forthwith a guarantee to reimburse the Town of San Anselmo should any damage result from moving the building across the concrete bridge. Seconded by Trustee Schradn and duly carried. A written guarantee acceptable to the Board was placed on file.

Trustee Stratford moved to allow the following bills for payment by warrant on the Treasurer. Seconded by Trustee Whitaker and duly carried.
