

September 6th 1911

The first Monday in September being a legal holiday the Board of Trustees of the Town of San Anselmo have met this date in accordance with the requirements of Ordinance No. 10 to fix the tax rate for the year 1911.

Pres. W. E. Jones called the meeting to order at 9 P. M.

There were present Trustees Gagan, Schradn, ~~Whitaker~~, Stratford and Jones.

Absent Trustee Whitaker.

Trustee Stratford introduced the following resolution and moved its adoption to-wit:

Resolved that One dollar ($\$1.00$) on each one hundred dollars ($\$100.00$) of the assessed valuation of all real and personal property and improvements be, and the same is hereby fixed as the rate for figuring taxes for municipal purposes of the Town of San Anselmo for the year 1911 and be it,

Resolved that forty six cents, one and four tenths mills ($\$.4614$) on each one hundred dollars ($\$100.00$) of the assessed valuation of all real and personal property and improvements be, and the same is hereby fixed as the rate for figuring taxes for the interest and redemption of bonds of the Municipal Improvement Fund and the Municipal Improvement Fund No. 2 and be it,

Resolved that forty three cents, eight mills and six tenths ($\$.4386$) on each one hundred dollars ($\$100.00$) of the assessed valuation of all real and personal property and improvements be, and the same is hereby fixed as the rate for figuring taxes for the interest and redemption of bonds of the Municipal Improvement Fund of

Sewer Dist. No. 1.

The motion to adopt said resolution was seconded by Trustee Schrader and carried by the following vote.

Ayes: Trustees Gagan, Schrader, Stratford & Jones.

Noes: None.

Absent: Trustee Whitaker.

Trustee Stratford moved to adjourn second by Trustee Gagan and carried.
