

Minutes November 1st 1912

The Board of Trustees of the Town met in regularly adjourned session on Friday evening, November 1st, 1912 at 8:15 P. M.

Present Trustees Crisp, Whitaker, Gogau, Salisbury and Schrader. Absent None.

The minutes of the meetings of October 9th and 19th were read and approved.

This being the time set for the opening of bids for the construction of two concrete bridges and for certain Roadwork as advertised, the Clerk was instructed to open the bids for the Concrete Culverts:

On motion of Trustee Gogau seconded by Trustee Whitaker the bids were referred to the entire board.
