

Minutes January 14th 1913.

At a regularly adjourned meeting of the Board of Trustees held on Tuesday evening January 14th 1913 at 8:00 o'clock P. M. the following members were present: Trustees Crisp, Whitaker, Tagan & Schrader. - Absent Trustee Falsbury.

The reading of the minutes of the last meeting was dispensed with.

The meeting having been called for the purpose of acting on the petition of S. J. Hall for a Liquor License, the Clerk was directed to read the Application and Protest against it. Communications from Olga A. Landgrebe and S. M. Hood were read and ordered placed on file.

On motion of Trustee Tagan, seconded by Trustee Crisp, it was decided to allow the Protestants 20 minutes to present their arguments against granting the license, the Applicant 30 minutes and the Protestants then 10 minutes to close.

Arguments being heard from both sides in regular order; Trustee Whitaker moved that the Application be denied. There being no second to the motion, the Board withdrew in Executive Session. After returning from Executive Session, Trustee Whitaker withdrew his motion, and the President announced that as the Board was divided on the subject that action would be postponed until Trustee Falsbury's return.

On motion duly seconded the meeting was then adjourned.
