

Minutes February 12th 1913

The Regular monthly meeting of the Board of Trustees was held on Wednesday evening February 12th 1913 at 8:30 P. M. Present Trustees Cisp, Whitaker, Doyan and Schreder. Absent Trustee Salisbury.

The minutes of the meetings of January 8th 1913, January 14th 1913 and February 3rd 1913 were read and approved.

A petition was read asking that no change be made in the present building laws within the fire limits, signed by thirteen property owners.

Another petition asking that buildings covered by metal lath and plaster be allowed within the fire limits, signed by ten property owners within the fire limits was then read.

A petition to the same effect, signed by twenty-two business men of San Anselmo was then read.

A petition asking that the fire limits be extended so as to include all the business section from Belle Avenue to Ross Valley Avenue, signed by forty-nine parties was read.

All motions duly made and seconded the petitions were received and placed on file.

Communications was received from Mrs. Happershug asking permission to move her dwelling. Referred to the Building Inspector.

An acceptance from Geo. M. Dodge Town Engineer on the two new concrete culverts was ordered placed on file.

A communication from the Faigue French Laundry was referred to the Town Marshall.

A communication from Arthur W. Studley asking permission to make alterations on Felud Street property was referred to the Building Committee.

On motion of Trustee Fagan seconded by Trustee Tins the Town Treasurer was authorized to transfer the balance of \$39.⁴⁹ left in the Bond money voted for the new bridge over San Anselmo creek to the General Fund.

Reports from the Marshall and Building Inspector were read and ordered placed on file.

Street Committee reported that conditions have confronted them in the matter of the Oak Street Extension that will require more time to enable them to submit a report.

Mr. Norton was requested to submit a new petition in the matter of the proposed Street Railway by Friday evening February 14th.

On motion of Trustee Fagan seconded by Trustee Whitaker the following bills were ordered paid by warrant drawn on the Treasurer
