

Minutes October 27<sup>th</sup> 1913

A regular adjourned meeting of the Board of Trustees was held on Monday evening October 27<sup>th</sup> 1913 at 8:30 P. M.

Present Trustees Wilson, Crisp, Kemp and Schrader. Absent Trustee Whitaker. The <sup>reading of the</sup> minutes of the previous meeting was dispensed with.

A letter from N. A. Eisenstein referring to a fire at Lonsdale was referred to the Clerk to answer.

Trustee Kemp offered the following resolution and moved its adoption to wit:-

Resolved that there be, and there is hereby created, the following funds for the purpose of dividing and apportioning the revenue of this Town, to-wit:

Election, General Government, Police, Fire Department, Street Sprinkling and Cleaning, Parks and Hall Grounds, Advertising, Street Maintenance and Repair, Library, Contingent Fund, Street Lighting and Sewer Repairs, New Streets.

Resolved further that there is hereby set aside out of the revenues for this fiscal year for the use and purposes of said several funds the sums set opposite the respective names of said funds, to-wit:

It is further Resolved that the Treasurer be and he is hereby authorized and directed out of the revenue for this fiscal year to appropriate and distribute the funds as hereinbefore set forth and that the Clerk of this board be and he is hereby instructed to keep and maintain accounts showing said several funds and amounts chargeable against and withdrawn from the same.

Said resolution was seconded by Trustee Wilson and adopted by the following vote: - Ayes Trustees, Wilson, Crisp, Kemp & Thader, Nays None Absent - Trustee Whitaker.

Town Attorney J. E. Manning was appointed by the chair to look into the matter of a Carnegie Library for Saw Auelino.

The matter of unpaid licenses was discussed by the Board. Town Marshall Geo. Martiny was instructed to collect from Mr. Cardone and the Town Attorney was instructed to report on the status of others.

The Curfew Ordinance was given its second reading and was adopted by the following vote: Ayes Trustees Wilson, Crisp, Kemp, Thader Nays None - Absent Trustee Whitaker.

Trustee Kemp was appointed as a committee of one to look into

the matter of examination of milk and cream as called for in the new milk Ordinance.

Mrs. Davidson and Dr. Van Ouden were heard from in reference to streets and gutters in the Davidson Tract. Matter was referred to the Street Committee.

On motion of Trustee Cisp, seconded by Trustee Wilson the following parties presented by the Town Marshall for his deputies, were approved of. - Angelo Arata, J. J. Hall, H. M. Kuhn, William Deyscher and H. A. Zanpher.

On motion duly seconded the meeting was then adjourned.
