

MINUTES OF SEPTEMBER 3RD, 1918

The Regular Monthly meeting of the Board of Trustees was held on Tuesday evening, September 3rd, 1918 at 8 o'clock P. M.

Present, Trustees Perry, Michener, Stephenson and Taylor.
Absent, Trustee Latham.

The minutes of the meeting of August 19, 1918 were read and approved.
Finance Committee

Trustee Michener was appointed as a member of the finance committee in the absence of Trustee Latham by the Chairman.

Community Singing

Upon motion of Trustee Michener, seconded by Trustee Perry, the request of the Community Singing organization for the use of the Town Hall on the ^{second} first and fourth Tuesdays of the month was granted.

Communications

A letter from the Gamewell Fire Alarm Telegraph Co. in reference to shortage of material for batteries was referred to the Manager and Fire Chief.

A letter from the League of California Municipalities and from the State Board of Health in reference to the coming annual convention of the league was read by the Clerk. Upon motion of Trustee Perry, seconded by Trustee Stephenson, Trustee Taylor was appointed as a delegate to the convention from the Town of San Anselmo.

An assignment of the payments on the lease of road machinery from A.L. Brizzolara to the First Bank of San Anselmo was ordered filed with the lease.

Reports

Reports were received and read from the Fire Chief, Deputy Marshal, and Marshall, Manager and Supt. of Streets. Upon motion of Trustee Perry, seconded by Trustee Michener, the reports were ordered filed and the recommendations in reference to improvement of Cedar Street between its present end and Ross Avenue and for the discontinuance of the County Road work at Saunders Ave. and starting on San Anselmo Avenue from Lansdale to Bolinas Ave. were approved.

Jitney Bus License

Trustee Michener introduced a Resolution Granting permission to E. A. Seipel to run a Jitney bus or Automobile for conveying passengers over the streets of San Anselmo between San Anselmo and Fairfax and between San Anselmo and San Rafael, and moved its adoption.

The motion to adopt said Resolution was seconded by Trustee Stephenson and carried by the following vote:
