MINUTES OF APRIL 6TH, 1931.

A regular meeting of the Council of the Town of San Anselmo was held on Monday, April 6th, 1931, at the hour of 8 o'clock PM.

Present: Councilmen McKannay, Siemer, Jordan, Wright and Fusselman.

The minutes of the meeting of March 2nd were approved as read.

Mr. Sheehy, representing the San Anselmo Post American Legion, requested the Council to consider the installation of a fire siren in place of the present bell alarm. The matter was taken under advisement by the Council.

COMMUNICATIONS:

A communication signed O.L. Stewart, Supt. S.R. Military Academy, asking permission to use the baseball grounds in San Anselmo daily between 3:30 and 5:30 excepting Saturdays and Sundays was read; upon motion of Councilman Siemer, seconded by Councilman Jordan, permission was granted.

A letter signed Mrs. C. Hughes advising Council that she is contemplating building on her property on Scenic Ave. and being unable to locate a sewer at that location, requests permission to install a septic tank until such time as a main sewer is constructed. The matter

was referred to the Parks & Housing Committee for consideration.

A communication from the Board of Supervisors advising Council that upon motion duly made and seconded, the request of the Council with reference to financial aid towards the improvement of Red Hill Ave. was denied was read and the Clerk was directed to petition the Board of Supervisors, on behalf of the Council, to make provision for such improvement in their budget this year.

Permission was granted Mrs. J. E. Clark to remove a dead elm tree from the sidewalk area fronting her property at 44 Tamalpais Ave.

Upon motion of Councilman Siemer the Chairman of the Street Committee was authorized to lease an engine block for the tractor from the Marin Co. Motors, with the understanding that the amount paid for such rental will apply towards the purchase of a new machine when funds are at hand. Motion was seconded by Councilman Wright and carried by the following vote;

Councilman McKannay introduced the following Resolution and moved its adoption:

(AMENDMENT TO FIRE ORDINANCE NO. 89:) #212

"An Ordinance Amending Sections 3 and 4 of Ordinance 89, as amended by Ordinance 157, relating to the building of bonfires and fires for disposal of trash, etc." was introduced for first reading and was read.

Upon motion of Councilman Siemer permission was granted Mr. Pinza to remove the bulkhead in front of his property on Pine St. and the Engineer was instructed to supervise the re-building of the curb and the necessary back-filling.
