APPOINTMENT OF PLAYGROUND COMMITTEE:

Councilman Scotford introduced the following Resolution and moved its adoption:

"WHEREAS certain public spirited residents of the Town of San Anselmo have undertaken a program for the acquisition and building of park and playground equipment, and

WHEREAS such a program has the complete approval of the City Council of the Town of San Anselmo, and said Council wishes to aid in the completion of such plans,

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the Town of San Anselmo hereby creates the SAN ANSELMO PARK AND PLAYGROUND COMMITTEE to exist under the following terms and conditions, to wit:

1. Said Committee shall consist of ten members, one of which shall be a member of this Council; said Committee to serve for a term of two years, from date, or at the pleasure of this Council.
2. Said Councilman member shall select nine other members of the Committee, one committeeman to be selected from each of the Religious, Patriotic, Fraternal Service and Educational organizations of the Town of San Anselmo.
3. This Committee shall serve as an advisory board only and shall in no wise have authority to perform any act or acts which shall be binding upon this Council or the Town of San Anselmo.
4. Said Committee shall not receive any salary or allowance of any kind or amount.
5. Said Committee shall make its reports, findings, and suggestions to this body from time to time, and at any time when so requested by this Council.
6. It shall be the duty of this Committee among other things to study the requirments for parks and for park and playground equipment in San Anselmo.
7. The Chairman of the Parks and Housing Committee of this Town shall be the Chairman and Councilman member of said Committee."

Motion to adopt said Resolution was seconded by Councilman Linch and carried by the following vote:
