

WHEREAS, the Pacific Greyhound has made application to the Public Utilities Commission for an increase in rates for passenger service in the County of Marin, and

WHEREAS, should said rate increase be granted it would be highly detrimental to the people of Marin County, and

WHEREAS, it is to the best interests of the people of the Town of San Anselmo and other areas in the County of Marin to oppose such application as prayed for,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the Town of San Anselmo as follows, to-wit:

1. That the Town of San Anselmo does hereby oppose the granting of rate increases prayed for by Pacific Greyhound.

2. That the Board of Supervisors of the County of Marin be, and they are hereby, respectfully urged and requested to oppose said application for rate increases, and in making such opposition to act on behalf of the Town of San Anselmo, and such other areas of Marin County as may request such action.

3. That the Clerk of the Town of San Anselmo be, and he is hereby, authorized and directed to forward a certified copy of this resolution forthwith to the Board of Supervisors of the County of Marin.
