
"Master Streets and Highway Planning" as presently being worked up by the County Planning Commission explained by Merritt Webster. Planning is being done on an over all basis of the existing facilities, contemplated requirements and traffic counts. It was concluded by the Council that this planning is a very sensible approach and rather than have individual planning which might later serve to bottleneck traffic, the council expressed interest in having the county plan made available for study. City Clerk to write to the County Planning Commission.

LOTS 1&2 Block 9 HAWTHORNE HILLS #3 - FREDERICKS EXCAVATION

After discussion of the excavation on the above property with the City Engineer, ^{the} ~~that~~ Council advised the City Clerk to inform Mr. Frederericks to cause the driveway wing walls to be installed to an elevation at least equal to the ruptured front wall and install the driveway slab and tie the slab into the wing walls, work to be done within thirty days of date of letter. It was also ordered that Mr. Fredericks bond be increased from \$200. to \$5000. Upon compliance with the above provisions, the Building Inspector was advised he could grant building permit. Foregoing action taken on the motion of Councilman Smith and seconded by Councilman Skinner.
