

A regular meeting of the San Anselmo City Council was held February 9th 1954, at 8:00 P.M. City Hall, San Anselmo, Calif.

Present: Councilman -Smith, Skinner, Wadlewski, Cudworth
 Absent: Councilman -Hannigan
 Mayor Cudworth, Presiding

On motion of Councilman Skinner and seconded by Councilman Wadlewski dispense with reading of the minutes of meeting of January 12th, 1954- Passed unanimously.

GEORGE WASHBURN & ARTHUR SMITH letter asking permission to trim three trees on the sidewalk area in front of their property on Bank St. The council grants permission to above parties to do this work.

E.E. GEORGE letter expressing appreciation to Lt. Serio for the recovery of a set of machinist tools which were taken from the NW Pacif RR Shop at Tiburon.

H.W. JOSLIN -letter asking permission to name street just completed to Fairview Court or Willow Way- On motion of Councilman Skinner and seconded by Councilman Smith permission to use Willow Way be granted - Passed unanimously.

RED CROSS letter asking Council to place seal of approval on Red Cross by issuing a proclamation designating the month of March, Red Cross month. Clerk to write letter to Red Cross approving same.

On motion of Councilman Wadlewski and seconded by Councilman Skinner "No left Turn" sign and right hand channellization at Sir Francis Drake & Bridge be left on trial basis. Passed unanimously.

On motion of Councilman Wadlewski and seconded by Councilman Smith application of San Anselmo Yellow Cab Co., to operate taxicabs on streets of San Anselmo be approved. Passed unanimously.

PUBLIC HEARING of petition of August Foglia & Silvio Ardito to rezone from 1st residential to commercial zone - Lot 3 Blk 2, and Lot 2 Blk 1 Map of Hawthorne Hills - On motion of Councilman Smith and seconded by Councilman Wadlewski council uphold decision of Planning Commission and rezone the above from 1st residential to C.H. Zoning - City Attorney to prepare necessary amendment. Passed unanimously.

APPLICATION OF ADJUSTMENT * F.J. Volber, 9 Plumas Ave., request to dispose of Lot 9, which has an area of 3760 sq.ft. On motion of Councilman Skinner and seconded by Councilman Wadlewski, council uphold the decision of the Planning Commission and grant this request. Passed unanimously.

APPLICATION OF ADJUSTMENT - Dave Lucas, 2 Berkeley Ave. San Anselmo request to construct a room on the cement floor of an existing patio - Councilman Wadlewski moves council uphold the decision of Planning Commission and grant this request. Councilman Smith second same. Passed unanimously.

WOODSON REALTY CO. presented tentative Map of Burchwood Park a new subdivision. On motion of Councilman Wadlewski and seconded by Councilman Smith tentative map be accepted subject to including sidewalks and curbs. Passed unanimously

On motion of Councilman Skinner and seconded by Councilman Smith Resolution ~~362~~, accepting deed of Wm. Parnow, et al., conveying to the Town of San Anselmo a certain paved street known as "Brookmead Place" on condition same is signed by two other partners. Passed unanimously.

ORDINANCE 361, "An ordinance amending ordinance No. 254 as amended by Ordinance #338 of the Town of San Anselmo, and changing the property classification of certain property in the Bush Tract, known as Lots 199 and 200, being property of R.E. Mullins and Hazel Huntington. On motion of Councilman Smith and seconded by Councilman Skinner above ordinance be accepted. Passed unanimously.

ORDINANCE 362, "An ordinance amending Ord. #254 as amended by Ord. #338 of the Town of San Anselmo and changing the property classification of certain property of Wm. Meagor, et al, Lots 2A, 3A and Lots B.C.D., Lot 4 Amended Map of Bush Tract #2, Read by Title only.

Recommendation of Chief of Police regarding driveway ordinance - asking council to correct a traffic hazard in connection with the present driveways from Sir Francis Drake Blvd. to the Lang properties occupied by Service Station and Drive-In recommendation and map referred to City Engineer for action.

Bldg Inspector & City Engineer to work in their prospective positions while work

is being done at city hall extension -City Council authorizes Chief Wood to make arrangements to have counter made at San Quentin for new office.

On motion of Councilman Smith and seconded by Councilman Skinner date of April 13th 1954 be set as date of Municipal Election. Passed unanimously

RESOLUTION 628, "No U Turn" at anytime at Drake Blvd and Bridge Rd. Councilman Wadlewski moves above resolution be approved. Seconded by Councilman Smith. Passed unanimously.

BIDS - Bids for the purchase of two (2) new police cars opened - bids opened as follows -

after checking above bids it was the decision of the council to hold same for further study.

On motion of Councilman Smith - Chief Marcucci to make application for fire truck for Civil Defense program at no cost to city - same not for use in first alarm fires - only secondary truck - City to furnish insurance - Councilman Wadlewski seconds same - Passed unanimously.

AEAG88 Councilman Wadlewski spoke on San Anselmo Recreation program -S.A. Committee on recreation would like town to furnish \$3000.00 for coming summer program. Assure committee \$2000.00. Councilman Wadlewski and Councilman Skinner to study on further funds.

Property at end of Alameda having large rock that is a hazard -Councilman Wadlewski will check with Mrs. Grant property location - and investigate further

On motion of Councilman Wadlewski "Not thru Street" sign be installed at SW corner of Alameda and Berkeley - Councilman Smith seconds same. Passed Unanim.

Councilman Wadlewski spoke regarding picket fence at Brookmead Ct - City Engineer to survey same - Councilman Wadlewski and Chief Marcucci to check.

On motion of Councilman Wadlewski and seconded by Councilman Smith rototiller be purchased for street department. Passed unanimously.

Councilman Skinner moves warrants 4779 to 4834 be approved for payment -holding up warrant 4834- Councilman Smith seconds same. Passed unanimously.

City Council will hold a meeting to discuss change in business license on February 25th at 8:00 P.M. Clerk to notify Chamber of Commerce it would be important to all businessmen to be present.

City Engineer asked for two certified copies of resolution making Cedar Street a street of major importance - City Attorney will take care of this matter Also suggest there be no parking on either side of Cedar St.

City Attorney to notify residence of Morningside Court they will have to remove cemented area which they put in on their property.

City Engineer reported foot bridge at Lincoln Park needs to be repaired by Town

Chief Wood spoke regarding L.A. Police Training Bulletin asking council to authorize S.A. Police Officers Assn., to subscribe to this bulletin @ 6.00 per man a year. 17 reserve and 12 regular police - Councilman Smith moves above be approved - Councilman Wadlewski seconds - Passed unanimously.
