

Minutes of San Anselmo Town Council Special Meeting - 8:35 P.M., June 5, 1975, at Robson House.

All members present.

HEARING ON TOWN ATTORNEY BUDGET # 416

The Town Attorney indicated agreement with the budget as recommended by the Administrator.

M/S Toal, Blinder to approve the Town Attorney Budget as submitted. Passed unanimously.

HEARING ON PARKS & RECREATION BUDGET # 481

The Director of Parks & Recreation and Judy Vallas of the School Board spoke to the need of allocation of grounds-keeper time to Red Hill field. The Director stated that such would be feasible only if both Federal Aid positions are continued. No action was taken, with the understanding that the Council would consider a transfer from reserves to support the second position should Federal funding end.

No action was taken in support of the Director's request for restoration of the Administrator's deletion in Account 11, conversion of trucks to power-steering.

As to Account 21 - Training - M/S Blinder, Anderson to add \$245 for a total of \$720, consisting of \$70 for a driver training program and \$175 for attendance of the Recreation Supervisor at a combined conference.

The Council next went to consideration of Capital Outlay items. Following a series of unsuccessful motions M/S Anderson, Blinder to restore \$700 in Account 44 for a gas range at Robson House, and \$450 in Account 43 for tables at Robson House.

M/S Blinder, Colteaux to restore \$400 to Account 44 for a total of \$800 for miscellaneous interior improvements at Robson, in relation to replacement of items recently stolen. Passed Unanimously.

Representatives of the Little League, as invited at a recent Council neighborhood meeting, presented a request for night lighting at Memorial Park. At a preliminary cost quotation of \$55,000, plus utility costs estimated at \$1,200 per month. No action taken, the sense of the Council being that a project of this magnitude should be considered in the context of the Capital Improvement Program and Budget scheduled for June 17th hearing.

Request by Mrs. Caroline Turner for paving of Memorial Park parking area was next considered. The Director reported a \$22,000 estimate for asphaltting, toward which the American Legion would contribute \$5,000. No action taken. The problem primarily being one of dust and danger caused by automobiles circling at high speed, Councilman Blinder suggested that the Tree Committee would consider the possibility of tree planting to inhibit such behavior.

The Council then considered recreation programs, with the Director citing increased labor and equipment costs, increased enrollment and no drop-off in any programs. M/S Toal, Anderson to restore the requested sum of \$29,714 for Account 47-A - Town Assisted Programs, as a whole.

The Commission requested that when the Council considers the Capital Improvements Budget on June 17th, it restore the good faith sum of \$10,000 toward purchase of Isabel Cook School multi-purpose building.

M/S Blinder, Anderson to approve the Park & Recreation Budget as amended for a total of \$252,178. Passed unanimously.

HEARING ON TOWN COUNCIL BUDGET # 411

M/S Colteaux, Blinder to reduce Account 21 to \$200, with the policy that Councilmen will not be reimbursed for dinners of the Council of Mayors and Councilmen. The motion filed to pass:

HEARING ON ADMINISTRATION & FINANCE BUDGET # 412

M/S Toal, Anderson to approve as recommended. Passed unanimously.

HEARING ON NON-DEPARTMENTAL BUDGET # 421

After discussion, M/S Blinder, Toal to reduce Account 10 - Promotion of Commerce - to \$750 providing for Bus Depot subsidy for six months, and eliminating funding of Chamber of Commerce.

M/S Toal, Blinder to approve the Non-Departmental Budget as amended for a total of \$19,163.
