Artificial turf issue should be well vetted.</li> <li>• Space should be saved for regular adult and senior programming.</li> <li>• Pathway around the park is very important.</li> <li>• Water is a huge issue to consider with the field.</li> <li>• In the dot exercise, you should have red dots for items people <u>don't</u> want.</li> <li>• Improve the entrance to the park.</li> <li>• Use the park for fairs and exhibits.</li> <li>• Not enough community members are participating in the process.</li> <li>• Don't marginalize dogs. The community is open to them.</li> <li>• A special area for dogs would be nice.</li> <li>• Dog use is an important park use.</li> <li>• The am and pm rules for dogs are working well for the regulars.</li> <li>• Keep picnic area large enough.</li> </ul>	<p>Q. <b>Can we keep the dinosaur in the playground?</b> A. Yes.</p> <p>Q. <b>What percentage of the community uses the park?</b> A. That's not known, but survey results may help.</p> <p>Q. <b>Do people outside of SA come to the park?</b> A. There are outside sports leagues, and the picnic area and playground are a draw.</p> <p>Q. <b>Would there be a separate area in the playground for toddlers and older kids?</b> A. Nothing is designed – it depends on what the community wants, but likely yes.</p> <p>Q. <b>Will we hear the pros and cons of artificial turf and does it work with dogs?</b> A. As the process moves forward, all these questions will be well vetted with the community. There are new types of artificial turf available.</p> <p>Q. <b>What is the lifespan of Red Hill Park?</b> A. It is near the end of its expected life.</p> <p>Q. <b>Is an outdoor pool possible?</b> A. It can be part of the discussion.</p> <p>Q. <b>What about the detention basin?</b> A. It is off the table per a voter initiative.</p> <p>Q. <b>Are field lights a possibility?</b> A. This can be vetted during the community process.</p>
